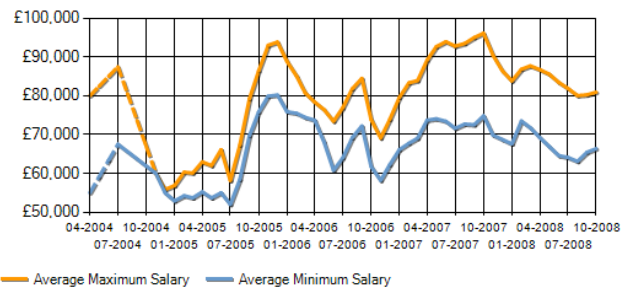

### Protect your Lifestyle

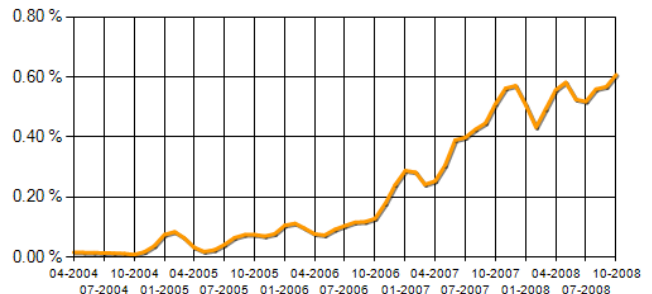
