# What's Happened Since Paris

---

- Two new projects formed
  - Service-Oriented Infrastructure
  - SOA and Security
- Progress on existing projects
  - SOA Governance CoBIT map developed
  - Practical Guide project exploring TOGAF ADM phases and SOA lifecycle
  - Reference Architecture project establishing principles and starting comparison of base document with other reference architectures
  - Ontology developed to point where we can consider preparing for publication
- White Paper on SOA published
- (And we defined “building block”)
