1 OVERVIEW

1.1 Introduction

This document contains guidelines for determining eligibility of Candidates to take the TOGAF 9 certification examinations at Accredited TOGAF Training Course (ATTC) providers. This document will be updated periodically based on feedback and the latest version can be obtained from the TOGAF 9 certification web site.

This document defers to the Certification Policy and the Accreditation Policy.

1.2 General Requirements

Accredited Training Course providers should ensure that only eligible candidates are entered to take the TOGAF 9 certification examinations and it is recommended that ATTC providers check each candidate’s eligibility as far in advance as possible.

If a candidate has failed an examination then they must wait the defined period of time prior to a resit. The current requirement at the time of writing is one month.



Please note that candidates sitting examinations for which they are not eligible will be disqualified from that examination, and the exam fees are non-refundable.

1.3 Candidate Eligibility

The following sections detail the eligibility requirements.

1.3.1 TOGAF 9 Part 1

There are no prerequisites for the TOGAF 9 Part 1. Any and all candidates are thus eligible to take this examination.

1.3.2 TOGAF 9 Part 2

A candidate must be certified to TOGAF 9 Foundation or have achieved a pass result for the TOGAF 9 Part 1 examination on the same day at the same ATTC provider as they are taking the Part 2 examination.

For candidates not taking the Part 1 exam in the same session, ATTC providers should check that a candidate has a TOGAF 9 Foundation entry in the Directory of Certified People at

Candidates are obliged to provide their *Personal Conformation Code* to the ATTC provider if they have set their directory entry to confidential.



The results for the TOGAF 9 Part 1 examination are made available instantly within the AOGEA IBT system, so candidates can proceed to take both the TOGAF 9 Part 1 and Part 2 examinations back to back.

1.3.3 TOGAF 8 – 9 Advanced Bridge

A candidate must have been TOGAF 8 Certified in order to be eligible to sit this examination.

ATTC providers should check that a candidate either has a current entry on the TOGAF 8 Certification register at

or the candidate should provide a copy of their certificate.



If ATTC providers are unsure on the eligibility of a candidate to take the *TOGAF 8 – 9 Advanced Bridge* exam they should contact togaf-cert-admin@opengroup.org with at least 3 days notice, providing the candidate's full name, the Registration Number that appears on the certificate, and the date of registration (also on the certificate).
