Security Forum Update

The Security Forum initiated work on two surveys as part of the Open FAIR™ Standard - EPSS Project and Open Information Security Management Processes Project. These surveys intend to gauge current industry practices and ensure planned deliverables meet industry needs. The Security Forum also began work on the next versions of the Zero Trust Commandments and the Zero Trust Reference Model Snapshot; the Zero Trust Commandments will proceed to a Standard, and the Zero Trust Reference Model will be updated to a new version.

The Open Group Technology Forum Updates

The Open Trusted Technology Forum continued working through areas of consideration for possible enhancement/expansion to the Open Trusted Technology Provider™ Standard (O-TTPS). These conversations were initiated at The Open Group Houston Summit in October 2023. As part of this effort, Forum Director John Linford presented the results from the OTTF's Supply Chain

Security Concerns Survey at the NIST Software and Supply Chain Assurance Winter Forum meeting and gave an overview of the initial mapping of the O-TTPS to the MITRE System for Trust at the Winter System of Trust Community Meeting.

The Assured Dependability Work Group Update

The Assured Dependability Work Group formally accepted its Project Charter, allowing elections to be held for Chair and Vice-Chair, electing Mr. Kyohichi Matsuzawa as Chair and Mr. Hirobumi Karamura as Vice-Chair. The Assured Dependability Work Group also continued to iterate on the Open Dependability through Assuredness (O-DA) Framework, Version 2.01, based on conversations from The Open Group Houston Summit in October 2023.
