

The Open FAIR™ 2 Foundation Certification

The Open FAIR™ 2 Foundation certification provides validation that an individual possesses knowledge and understanding of the Open FAIR model, taxonomy, and method for understanding, analyzing, and measuring information risk.

The learning objectives for this certification focus on knowledge and comprehension. This certification leads to the award of a certificate and an Open Badge.



Competencies

Certified individuals will have the following competencies:

- A taxonomy to communicate effectively with other Open FAIR risk analysts, removing ambiguity from risk estimates
- A scientific approach to estimate and analyze risk, improving the quality of risk analysis in the information security profession
- A terminology aligned with the business, bridging the gap between technical experts and management, facilitating decisions

Target Audience

- Individuals who require a basic understanding of the Open FAIR Body of Knowledge, including the Risk Analysis (O-RA) Standard, and the Risk Taxonomy (O-RT) Standard
- Professionals who are working in roles associated with a risk analysis project, such as those responsible for planning, execution, development, delivery, and operation
- Risk analysts who are looking for a first introduction to the Open FAIR Body of Knowledge, the O-RA Standard, and the O-RT Standard

The Value of this Certification

Certified individuals will have demonstrated their understanding of:

- The basic concepts of risk analysis
- The risk taxonomy and terminology
- How to develop and interpret Open FAIR risk analysis results
- The process of risk analysis
- How risk elements can be measured

Certification is only achieved by passing the examination.
